RE: Year 13 Pre Public Examinations

As we start the second half of the Spring term, the Pre Public Examination preparations begin for all year 13 students. With only ten school weeks remaining before the summer external exam, these exams provide the students with a final opportunity to develop their practice. The exams start on the 24th February 2025 and will last for two weeks for the students. We will follow all the normal rules and regulations that apply in the official examinations. The majority of the Year 13 exams will take place in the main examination hall. This experience will expose students to the process and regulations they will undergo in the summer and will help them to familiarise themselves with what to expect in the final A'level/CamTECH exams. The majority of the exams will take place in the morning or the afternoon, which means that some exams will finish after our normal end of school time. We encourage parents and students to check individual timetables and make appropriate arrangements to get home safely. The general full timetable is overleaf.

Students are expected to attend their normal timetabled lesson unless they are in an exam. Attendance to lessons has a huge impact on the attainment of students and the teachers will be able to impart some key knowledge and tips which will help maximise their examination performance.

The results from these exams will be used by teachers and students to make appropriate curriculum adaptations and help plan for the remainder of the academic year. Results from exams will be uploaded onto Go 4 Schools for students and parents to access and reflect. We will notify you when you can access the results.
