## Hot weather arrangements

Dear Parents / Carers,

I am writing to you regarding arrangements for this week due to the high temperatures we are experiencing and expecting this week. It is very important that all members of the school community are not placed at risk due to the severe weather warnings. Uniform rules have been relaxed, and students do not have to wear blazers, jumpers or ties.

### Preparing for hot weather

- Please ensure that your children come to school prepared for the heat.
- All should bring water bottles that can be refilled at the fountain.
- Leaving these in the freezer overnight will help.
- Sun cream and hats should be used outside.
- If your child has a health condition that places them at risk, please make contact with your child's year team at the school.
- Practical PE sessions will be moved inside to classrooms this week.
- Year 10 and 12 exams will only take place in the sports hall during the early morning session.
